We hope you have all had a successful 2018 and look forward to reconnecting in the New Year.







### SPINOZA AWARD



Dominique Moisi, Senior Advisor of the French Institute of International Relations and influential French-Jewish political scientist and an acclaimed expert on international relations, as well as our renowned GMP evening speaker, has been awarded the Spinoza Prize. This prize, awarded every two years since 1999, celebrates internationally renowned thinkers who concern themselves with ethics and society.
